Demonstration and Instructions for the Balance and Counting Stage

You must keep both legs straight, arms at your side. While holding that position, count out loud in the following manner: 'one thousand and one, one thousand and two, one thousand and three, until told to stop."

Demonstrated by Officer (for Officer safety, Officer does not look at his foot) counting "one thousand and one, one thousand and two, one thousand and three, etc."

"Keep your arms at your sides at all times and keep watching the foot. Do you understand?" Officer should acknowledge understanding by subject.

"Go ahead and perform the test."

Officer should always time the 30 seconds and observe the subject from a safe distance. If the subject places a foot down, the Officer should give instructions to "pick the foot up again and continue counting from the point at which the foot touched the ground." Always terminate the test at 30 seconds.
